## **Toddler Learner Outcomes**

### **Independence and Personal Care**

The child demonstrates an ability to:

- Feed himself/herself using appropriate utensils.
- Pour water from a pitcher
- Assist in clean up of snack and lunch
- Washes and dries own hands
- Independently uses the toilet
- Undresses and dresses self
- Puts on shoes

### **Physical Development**

- Demonstrates Age appropriate gross motor coordination including:
  1. Cross pattern walking
  2. Running
  3. Jumping
  4. Balancing
- Demonstrates age appropriate fine motor coordination including:
  1. Use of pincer grasp
  2. Eye- hand coordination
- Able to control body movements

### **Language Development**

- Has a vocabulary of 200 or more words
- Speaks in complete sentences
- Can follow a short sequence of commands (3)
- Verbally relates own experiences

### **Social/ Emotional Development and Work Habits**

- Can initiate own activity, choosing one activity from among many
- Able to focus on one activity and completes a work cycle, including returning activity to the proper place
- Is able to play cooperatively with other children
- Demonstrates appropriate social interactions
- Demonstrates the ability to problem solve
- Demonstrates age appropriate mentoring
- Demonstrates knowledge of age appropriate limits and expectations regarding routines
